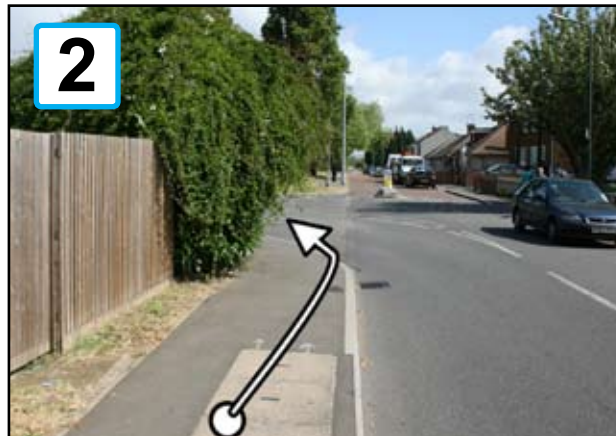

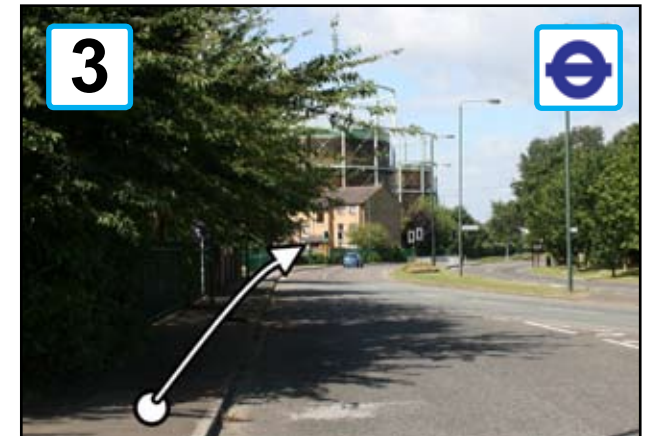
Exit from platform 2 side of station onto Norman Road. Go along the left side of Norman Road. Pass Maida Rd.

Go past Sutherland Rd and Waterfield Close. Follow the next left turning, it takes you to a dual carriageway (Yarnton Way).

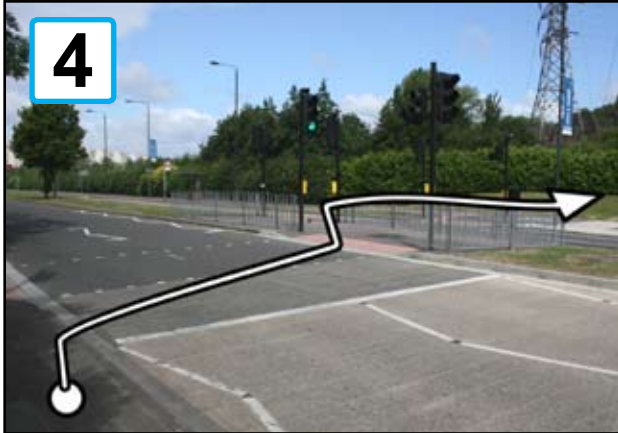

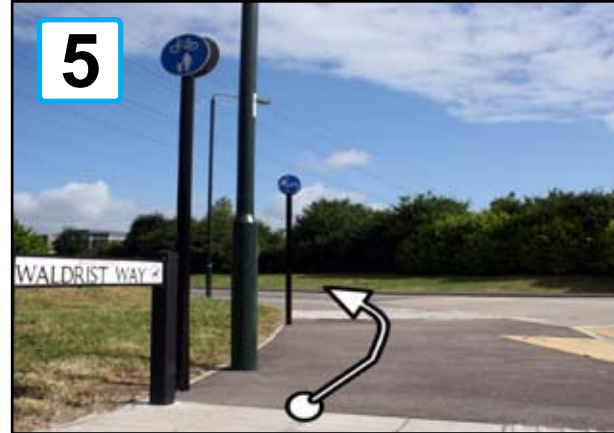
Keep going along the left hand side of Yarnton Way. Pass Centurian Way.

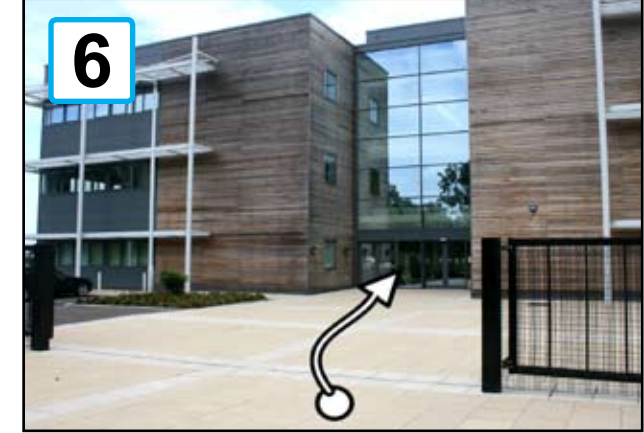

At the 2nd pedestrian crossing cross over Yarnton Way. Turn right along Yarnton Way to reach Waldrist Way.



Turn left to follow Waldrist Way. Go along the left hand side of the road.



The next road on your left is Veridion Way. The Thames Innovation Centre entrance is in front of you.
